



The ceremony opened with the flower girl and ring bearer singing a traditional Jewish song for the Havdalah service. Family members served as bridesmaids and groomsmen as the two exchanged vows in the resort's magnificent open-air chapel overlooking the Sea of Cortez. Candles, fire torches and a chuppah designed by Milana herself elegantly decorated the space.

"The best moment was when I walked down the aisle and we both stepped under the chuppah," says Milana. "It was as if we were the only two people there and we were truly part of a spiritual experience."

At the reception, a band from Israel played "Bésame Mucho" as the newlyweds shared their first dance. The resort's chef prepared a multi-course meal and a traditional French croquembouche. Beachside fireworks at midnight added to the celebration.




